### **To Run The Program**

Type the information for the picking tickets you are selecting.

Press "enter" to produce these picking tickets. Note: No block is mandatory. Choose one way to select picking tickets or choose several, the choice is yours.

If you want more selections and your screen is full, press "Enter". Your full page of selection is accepted. The screen is cleared and you are ready to make more selections.

You can select picking tickets based upon the following:

<b>FIELD</b>	<b>DESCRIPTION OR ACTION</b>
<b>START SHIP FROM-TO</b>	MMDDYY-MMDDYY.
<b>COMP DATE FROM-TO</b>	MMDDYY-MMDDYY
<b>CUSTOMER (6)</b>	Customer number. Type ship to number.
<b>LOG RANGE (12)</b>	Log range. Order log number. Type the from and to log numbers to be selected for picking tickets.
<b>PR Priority (1)</b>	Type the priority code.

***A9830 \* PICKING TICKET SELECT***

- STYLE (8)** Style. Type the style number.
- CLR (4) Color.** Type the color number or name.
- COOR GROUP (2)** Coordinate group. Requires style and color. Type group code.
- LINE (3)** Line. Type a particular line or lines in an order, requires log number.
- CUT-NO (5)** Cut number. It is possible to update specific lines on orders in combination with any of the fields entered from above by typing a cut number in this field on the same line.
- DYE LOT (2)** Dye lot. Type the dye lot number in conjunction with the above described cut number.
- SL Select (1)** If left blank, all lines in orders within the parameters on the select record will be updated with the cut number and dye lot, but no picking tickets will be printed.
- Type a "P" for lines in orders you wish to update with cut number and dye lot and select the picking tickets to be printed.
- Type an "S" if lines have previously been updated and you are now selecting the picking tickets by using the cut number and dye lot. This is for users of A5600 cut allocation program.

Press "enter" to update. Press "F8" program will ask you to press F1 to update. After pressing F1 program will close Press "F8" to exit this program.

Listf WM43MC,2. To delete Selection go to A9830 and blank out your selection with a space bar.
